I am requesting funding in the amount of \$2,333,629 for the following project in surface transportation reauthorization legislation:

**Acquisition of Signs and Shelters in Bryan/College Station, Texas**

The project sponsor for this project is the Brazos Transit District, and the project is located in the cities of Bryan and College Station, Texas.

The funding is designated to purchase and install 54 shelters and 265 signs along the 10 fixed routes currently operated by the Brazos Transit District in the Bryan/College Station area.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and is anticipated to have the benefit of modernizing the transit system in Bryan/College Station to improve passenger safety and accessibility, and to be consistent with large urban transit industry standards.
