Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I respectfully request funding for the Corridor A2 Segment – Advanced Technology Route Project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive this funding is Williamson County, Texas, located at 710 S. Main Street, Ste. 101, Georgetown, TX 78626.

This \$10,000,000 request would be used to construct a roadway to include the addition of a connecting road from FM 973 to State Highway 95. The Corridor A2 Project would extend an existing transportation corridor that is critical for access to high-tech facilities and shipment of high-tech components through Williamson County. This work will greatly expand the roadway capacity in that area. The project will increase mobility and connectivity for residents to jobs, schools, and retail areas. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide a critical route for residents to access jobs at the nearby economically significant commercial and industrial facilities, including the RCR Freight Facility and the City of Hutto Industrial Mega Site.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133(b), the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program.
