I respectfully request funding for the Nacogdoches Multimodal Transit Facility Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive this funding is the Brazos Transit District, located at 2117 Nuches Lane, Bryan, Texas 77803.

This \$1,000,000 request would be used to acquire property and initiate site preparation for a permanent transit transfer facility in the City of Nacogdoches, Texas. The project will include land acquisition and initial capital improvements such as site assessment, grading, utility connections, bus parking and circulation areas, and basic operational infrastructure to support transit services.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it ensures continuity of public transportation services in Nacogdoches and surrounding rural communities that rely on transit for access to employment, healthcare, education, and essential services. The current temporary transfer location is expected to be redeveloped, and without a permanent replacement site, transit operations would face significant disruption. Establishing a dedicated facility will improve safety, operational efficiency, and long-term reliability of regional transit service.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized chapter 53 of title 49 of the United States Code.
