Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I respectfully request funding for the Deep East Texas Interoperable Communications Infrastructure in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive this funding is the Deep East Texas Council of Governments, located at 1405 Kurth Drive, Lufkin TX 75904.

The requested amount of \$4,400,000 would be used by the Deep East Texas Council of Governments to purchase interoperable communications equipment for use by law enforcement across Houston, Trinity, and Nacogdoches Counties. This equipment would enable law enforcement and first responders in these counties to connect to the statewide Texas Wide Area Radio Network (TxWARN), allowing for significantly improved communications during emergency situations. This request is a good use of taxpayer funds because it will facilitate interoperable communication with statewide law enforcement entities in this rural three county region. This region is one of very few remaining in the State of Texas that is not interoperable with the TxWARN network, and the only remaining area in the Houston-area hurricane evacuation zone.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 1701(b)(8) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(8))
