I respectfully request funding for the Future I-69/U.S. 59 Feasibility Study and Environmental Clearance for Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive this funding is the City of Nacogdoches, TX, located at 202 East Pilar Street, Nacogdoches, TX 75961.

The requested amount of \$5,000,000 would be used to complete a feasibility study and environmental clearance to begin work on the remaining gap for U.S. Route 59 between Nacogdoches and Lufkin, Texas.
