I respectfully request funding for the Corridor A2 Segment – Advanced Technology Route Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive this funding is Williamson County, Texas, located at 3151 SE Inner Loop, Suite B, Georgetown, TX 78626.

This \$10,000,000 request would be used to construct a roadway to include the addition of a connecting road from FM 973 to State Highway 95. The Corridor A2 Project would extend an existing transportation corridor that is critical for access to high-tech facilities and shipment of high-tech components through Williamson County. This work will greatly expand the roadway capacity in that area. The project will increase mobility and connectivity for residents to jobs, schools, and retail areas.
