Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I respectfully request funding for the Ground Storage Tank Rehabilitation and System Pressure Improvement project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive this funding is the City of Woodway, Texas, located at 922 Estates Drive, Woodway, TX, 76712.

This \$1,150,000 request would fund the resurfacing and distribution system upgrades for two of the City's ground storage tanks. The tanks are located at the Acorn and Tater Hill pump stations. These tanks have not been resurfaced in many years and during the latest inspection, the Texas Council on Environmental Quality indicated the exteriors are in need of rehabilitation. This project will also include a replacement of the distribution system from the storage tanks to the main water line. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will rehabilitate an existing water storage system and ensure that the City of Woodway is able to provide a clean and reliable supply of drinking water to its growing population.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
