I respectfully request funding for the Bruceville-Eddy Sewer System Expansion I Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive this funding is the City of Bruceville-Eddy, located at 144 Wilcox Drive, Eddy, Texas 76524.

This \$3,248,872 request would be used to construct additional sewer mains, lift station connections, and residential service lines to expand the City's wastewater system to additional service areas currently reliant on aging private septic systems. This expansion will connect approximately 46 additional households to the municipal sewer system, eliminating failing septic tanks that pose risks to groundwater, nearby creeks, and drinking water sources.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve public health, protect local and downstream water resources, and ensure the City's wastewater system operates at its intended capacity. Completing the remaining construction components while contractors are already mobilized will also reduce overall project costs and prevent future duplication of engineering, procurement, and construction mobilization expenses.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a)(2).
