I respectfully request funding for the Corridor A2 Segment 1 Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive this funding is Williamson County, Texas, located at 3151 SE Inner Loop, Suite B, Georgetown, Texas 78626.

This \$10,000,000 request would be used to construct a frontage road segment from FM 973 to CR 406 as part of Corridor A2, a critical east-west transportation corridor supporting rapid industrial and population growth in eastern Williamson County. This phase is part of a broader, multi-segment buildout of a four-lane access-controlled roadway with frontage roads and freight-supporting infrastructure.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it addresses significant transportation demand driven by major economic investments, including domestic semiconductor manufacturing and associated industrial development. The project will improve mobility, reduce congestion, enhance roadway safety, and support efficient freight movement critical to national supply chains. Federal funding will also leverage substantial local investment, including voter-approved bond funding, to accelerate delivery of essential infrastructure in one of the fastest-growing regions in Texas.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in 23 U.S.C. 133.
